 - Denver International Airport – This airport is approximately 136 miles from Laramie on the shortest route. Is the most common airport utilized for travel to and from Laramie because of the numerous flights available and reliability of those flights.
 - Laramie Regional Airport – This airport is 3 miles west of Laramie. This airport has a limited number of flights a day in or out of Laramie. This airport hubs through Denver International Airport.
 - Cheyenne Regional Airport – This airport is approximately 52 miles away from Laramie on Interstate I-80. Similar to Laramie, has limited number of flights a day in or out of Cheyenne. This airport hubs through Denver International Airport.

Weather:

- Laramie is at 7,100 ft of elevation and thus the weather in July is typically wonderful with daytime temperatures in the 80's. However, you are in Wyoming and the weather can be variable (cold and wet is possible, there is still a slim chance for snow).
- We will be at high elevation, in a dry and arid landscape, which means hydration, sun exposure, and dressing for changing and variable weather would be in your best interest.
- Wyoming is also known for having wind, thus jackets or wearing layers can make your stay more pleasurable.
